No person may commence or proceed with the construction, reconstruction, alteration, repair, movement, to another site, removal, or demolition of any building without first securing from the inspection department with jurisdiction over the site of the work each permit required by the State building Code and any other State or local law or ordinance or regulation applicable to the work". GS 153 A-357

During the entire work process, it shall be the contractor/owner's responsibility to maintain the site in a safe and sanitary condition. All discarded debris must be removed from the site, disposed in an approved landfill in compliance to all Federal, State and County Regulations. Upon completion of all demolition and removal, it shall be the contractor/owner's responsibility to fill and grade the lot in a manner that will prevent the ponding and accumulation of water. The lot must conform to local zoning requirements, street and adjoining properties grades.
